VSO will assess each submission based on Selection Panel Report, and will be based on compliance with this Request for Quotation (RFQ), ability to meet the requirement as specified and overall value for money using the following criteria:

- How you propose to provide the Goods/Services specified in this RFQ.
- Demonstrated ability to manage/deliver the Goods/Services in terms of:
 - The range and quality of Goods/services offered;
 - Understanding of the requirement, ability to meet deadlines, implementation methodology and project management processes;
 - Proven subject matter expertise;
- Past relevant performance (including goods/service delivery, performance management and assurance), and
- Expertise of particular individual(s) and subcontractors nominated to perform or provide the Goods/Services.
- The fee to be charged for providing the Goods/Services. Bidders may be invited to give a presentation or attend a clarification interview.

VSO shall not be bound to accept any quotation and will not be responsible for any loss or expense incurred by firms in the submission of their quotations. VSO reserves the right to accept all or part of an offer.

The successful supplier will be appointed to VSO's framework for the below stated packages of work. It is VSO's intention to order from framework.

Specification of Requirements

1. Challenge Fund for Youth Employment

The Challenge Fund for Youth Employment (CFYE) is a 6-year and €114 million+ programme funded by the Netherlands Ministry of Foreign Affairs, that aims to create a prosperous future for 230,000 young women and men in the Middle East, North Africa, Sahel & West Africa and Horn of Africa regions. The Fund supports initiatives in up to 23 countries that will offer youth, in particular young women, opportunities for work that is demand-driven and productive, offering a stable income and safe working conditions, and that is contributing to their personal development and social protection.

At the moment, the Fund provides Co-funding and Technical Assistance (TA) to (consortia of) private sector companies in approximately 17 countries in Africa and the Middle-East so that they can create, match or improve jobs for youth. CFYE is implemented by VSO, Randstad and Palladium – www.fundforyouthemployment.nl

2. Objective of the Assignment

In this assignment you support the Fund's ambition to ensure private sector portfolio companies maximize impact for and with young men and women.

To achieve this, CFYE's work is fully aligned to the Fund's Youth Quality Work Journey, in other words how companies Attract, Select and Retain youth, and young women, in particular.

The Journey of young talent through the three key stages (Attract, Select, and Retain) is supported by 10 Building Blocks that can be optimized.

Attract young talent by optimizing:

- 1: Online Youth Marketing
- 2: Community-Based Youth Outreach

Select young talent by optimizing:

• 3: Youth-Inclusive Recruitment

Retain young talent by optimizing:

- 4: Young Professional Development Opportunities
- 5: Peer Networks
- 6: Space for Youth Voice
- 7: Youth-Focused Secondary Benefits
- 8: Young Parent-Specific Benefits
- 9: Youth-Focused Respect & Dignity at Work
- 10: Gender-Inclusive Practice

In this assignment you will develop resource toolkits (core activity 1), design, conceptualize and run cross-portfolio Solution Searching Workshops and Cross-Portfolio Collaboration Hubs (core activity 2 & 3) with CFYE's private sector portfolio and in collaboration with the CFYE team.

3. Key Activities

Core Activity 1: Develop Resource Toolkits on 5 Key Youth Impact Topics for Private Sector Companies

- 1. Youth-inclusive recruitment.
- 2. Space for Youth Voice.
- 3. Community-Based Youth Outreach.

- 4. Online Youth Marketing.
- 5. Youth-Relevant and Young Parent-Specific Benefits.

Stage 1 | Preparation

- Undertake a quick scan of what materials have already been developed on each of the five priority topics and establish what good looks like.
- Make a high-level analysis of strengths and weaknesses of the existing materials / gaps of the existing resources (if any).
- Present a broad outline of the toolkit.

Stage 2 | Development of resource

- Develop the practical, impact-driven and business relevant standardized resource / toolkit on the 5 topics for CFYE portfolio companies operating in Africa and the Middle-East.
- Validate the toolkit with selected team members, especially members of Integrated Country Delivery teams.

Stage 3 | Dissemination to the portfolio

- Turn the resource into an E-learning Module through CFYE's Learning Platform
- Ensure the tool(kit) is CFYE branded.

Core Activity 2 & 3: Design and Deliver Cross-Portfolio Solution Searching Workshops and Cross-Portfolio Collaboration Hubs (Community of Practices)

Stage 1 | Preparation

- Quick scan of CFYE's Youth Quality Work Journey, Youth Impact Growth Matrix and Youth Impact Growth Profiles of the portfolio companies.
- Hold Insight Talks with a selection of the CFYE team members to understand needs, targets and past learnings.
- Hold Insight Talks with a selection of CFYE portfolio companies to understand needs and targets.

Stage 2 | Design & Conceptualize

- Based on phase 1, conceptualize the Solution Searching Workshops and Cross-Portfolio Collaboration Hubs (Community of Practices) for CFYE.
- Set-up a Refinement Session with selected CFYE team members and / or CFYE portfolio companies, to finetune and finalize the concepts and decide on the content focus.
- Create and present a plan for roll-out.

Stage 3 | Roll-out of Concepts in the CFYE portfolio

- Run three Cross-Portfolio Solution Searching Workshops on a variety of the 10 Building Block topics from across the Youth Quality Work Journey (One in 2023, Two in 2024).
- Set-up and run three Cross-Portfolio Collaboration Hubs (Community of Practices) on diverse topics related to *Attracting* Youth, *Selecting* Youth & *Retaining* Youth, starting in 2023 and running into Q1 / Q2 of 2024.

Stage 4 | Training of Team

• Provide a Training of Trainers to a selection CFYE country and central team members to independently run Solution Searching Workshops and Collaboration Hubs.
